## WCNC'17 Startup City

Startups whose products are geared towards customers throughout the wireless ecosystem are invited to join the inaugural WCNC'17 Startup City. Startup City participants will be provided with a 10x10 exhibit booth adjacent to the plenary lecture hall and main exhibit hall for the duration of the conference (March 20-22), as well as 4 exhibit-only badges. In addition to the exhibit booth, Startup City participants will be invited to a Startup Showcase to "pitch" conference delegates and patrons about their products and technology. Startups will be judged based on the showcase and their exhibit by a distinguished panel as well as attendees, and awards for the "WCNC'17 Hottest Wireless Startup" will be awarded at the conference banquet. Any privately-held company is eligible to participate in the WCNC'17 Startup City. The cost is \$2000.
